Agenda Item 3: Discussion paper on procedural guidance for committees working by correspondence

The Republic of Korea would like to thank the Codex Secretariat, legal offices of FAO and WHO for preparing the document on the 'Discussion paper on procedural guidance for committees working by correspondence'. We appreciate the opportunity to provide comments on this issue.
