

# MATTERS ARISING FROM THE CODEX ALIMENTARIUS COMMISSION AND OTHER CODEX COMMITTEES

## A. 42ND SESSION OF THE CODEX ALIMENTARIUS COMMISSION (CAC42)

#### Matters for information

#### Member for Africa<sup>1</sup>

1. CAC42 elected The United Republic of Tanzania as member of the Executive Committee for Africa for the period from the end of CAC42 to the end of CAC44 (currently scheduled for 2022).

#### Matters for action

### Codex Strategic Plan 2020-2025<sup>2</sup>

2. CAC42 encouraged all Members to participate in the development of the work plan for implementation of the Codex Strategic Plan 2020-2025 through the upcoming discussions at the FAO/WHO Coordinating Committees and other fora as they arise. This matter **will be considered** under Agenda Item 7.2; one aspect related to Strategic Goal 3 will be considered under Agenda Item 8.

# Coordinator for Africa<sup>3</sup>

3. CAC42 noted that as the sessions of the six FAO/WHO Coordinating Committees had been postponed by one year to the second half of 2019. Kenya would remain in office until the end of CAC43 (2020). The new Regional Coordinator for Africa would be nominated at CCAFRICA23, be appointed by CAC43, and hold office from the end of that session. This matter **will be considered** under Agenda Item 14.

#### 77th Sessions of the Executive Committee (CCEXEC77)

#### Matters for action

Committee on Processed Fruits and Vegetables (CCPFV)4

- 4. CCEXEC77 noted the interest in activating the work on cashew kernels and that members were encouraged to participate in the work of CCPFV and this could be further discussed in the upcoming FAO/WHO Coordinating Committees (RCCs).
- 5. CCAFRICA is encouraged to consider whether CCPFV should develop a standard for this commodity.
