We would like to request clarification on whether this provision allows the use of INS405 and INS477 in foods conforming to this standard, regardless of Notes linked to these food additives, i.e. Note194 and Note371 for INS405 and Note153 for INS477, in Table1 and 2 of General Standard for Food Additive (CXS192-1995) in food category 06.4.3.	Japan
If INS405 and INS477 are acceptable for use in foods conforming to this standard regardless of these Notes, we propose to add thickener and emulsifier in this provision, as INS405 is used as thickener and INS477 is used as emulsifier.	
"Acidity regulators, antioxidants, colors, preservatives, stabilizers, thickener and emulsifier in accordance with Tables 1 and 2 of General Standard for Food Additives (CXS 192-1995) in food category 06.4.3 Pre-cooked pastas"	
Regarding INS 340(ii) and INS 450(iii), if they are acceptable for use in foods conforming to this standard regardless of Notes211 and Note475 in Table1 and 2 of General Standard for Food Additive (CXS192-1995) in food category 06.4.3, we propose to delete them from the table.
