Position nationale:

1. Paragraph 27, ii), we consider it necessary to support the introduction of amendments to the texts of all Codex standards in connection with the entry into force of the standard CXS 346-2021 "General Standard for Labeling of Food Transport Containers" in terms of supplementing the sections of the standards on labeling with a reference to the above standard, but with some additional text.

For example, in the standard CXS 36-1981 (as amended in 2013) "Standard for quick frozen fish, whole and gutted", we consider it necessary, in addition to providing a reference to the standard CXS 346-2021 "General Standard for Labeling of Food Transport Containers", to retain additional information on the requirements for the name of the product (cutting, type of processing, etc.), expiration date, date of manufacture, storage conditions.

2. Paragraph 27, iii), we consider it impossible to use the methods for determining ammonia nitrogen (AOAC 920.04 and AOAC 920.03) to determine amine group nitrogen in CXS 302-2011 "Standard for Fish Sauce" and propose to leave the determination of amine group nitrogen using the methods AOAC 2.066 and AOAC 2.065, previously specified in this standard.
3. Paragraph 27, iv), we consider it possible to include *Sardinella fimbriata* and *Sardinella sirm* in CXS 94-1981 "Standard for Canned Sardines and Sardine Products" if the Committee has sufficient supporting materials.
