Revision of the Classification of Food and Feed

Agenda Item 7(e): Class B – Primary food commodities of animal origin Harmonization of meat mammalian maximum residue limits between CCPR and CCRVDF

Plant protection and veterinary services of Codex member countries are kindly invited to provide feedback in reply to CL 2022/36-PR for consideration by CCPR53. The findings of the consideration of this matter will be forwarded to CCRVDF26 (2023) for consideration. Note that CAC44 (2021) adopted a definition for edible offal as proposed by CCRVDF25 (2021) based on the recommendation of CCPR51 (2019).

Establishment of Codex MRLs for pesticides

Agenda Items 10/11/12: Engagement of JMPR in parallel reviews of new compounds, Management of unsupported compounds, national registration of pesticides

These items deal with how CCPR can further improve the establishment of MRLs for pesticides for food and feed under the procedures described in the *Risk Analysis Principles for the Establishment of Maximum Residue Limits for Pesticides by the Committee on Pesticide Residues* and decisions taken by CCPR at previous sessions that complement the guidance provided in the Risk Analysis Principles. Codex members and observers are kindly invited to consider the conclusions and recommendations in these papers in a holistic manner in order to provide useful guidance to CCPR when considering these agenda items in particular vis-à-vis their relation to further improvements to the establishment of schedules and priority lists for evaluation/re-evaluation by JMPR.

Agenda Item 13: Establishment of Priority lists of pesticides for evaluation/re-evaluation by JMPR

The elaboration of the Priority List corresponds to Step 1 of the Codex MRLs Elaboration Procedure. CCPR will consider a document prepared by the EWG/Priorities as presented in CX/PR 22/53/15 and comments submitted during the discussion on Agenda Items 5(b) and 6.
