

## **Background**

- 1. The 47th Session of the Committee (CCFL47) agreed that the paper on future work and emerging issues would be updated by Italy<sup>1</sup>.
- 2. To assist the development of the paper on future work and emerging issues, CCFL47 agreed to request Members and Observers to provide information on issues for inclusion in the paper.

## **REQUEST FOR COMMENTS**

- 3. Member Governments and Observers are invited to provide information on future work and emerging issues relevant to the work of CCFL to the addresses indicated above by **15 April 2024.**
- 4. In identifying future work/emerging issues, Members are requested to keep in view the issues identified for consideration as future work in CX/FL 23/47/13<sup>2</sup> and the decisions of CCFL47<sup>3</sup>.
- 5. In making submissions, the Members are requested to indicate whether the new work/emerging issue, if taken up as new work proposal, in accordance with the *Criteria for the Establishment of Work Priorities* (see Codex Procedural Manual), would likely lead to preparation of a new standard/guideline or revision of an existing standard/guideline.
