The platform shall generate different types of Revenue Streams, ranging from onetime customer payments (pay-as-you-go) e.g. generated from some direct stakeholder funding aimed at launching a dedicated Virtual Workspace for a user community, or from partner organizations willing to reuse existing results that do not have exclusivity rights.

2.3.6 Recurring revenues

They can come from organizations having long-term goals, involving large communities, spread across different regional organizations for example, and willing to plan for the conduct of regular platform operations.
