FishStatJ - Software for Fishery and **Aquaculture Statistical Time Series**

FishStatJ is a Windows and Mac application that anyone can use to access FAO's Fisheries and Aquaculture statistics. They include datasets on production, trade and consumption. Data can be extracted and aggregated according to different level of details and international standard classifications. It consists of a main application and several workspaces that include the datasets.

x64.exe, Oracle registration).

 - for macOS (macOS Catalina: refer to the included PDF)

In order to open the new 2020 workspace you need to install the latest version of FishStatJ.

Workspaces are downloaded directly from within the FishStatJ application menu *Manage workspaces*. Select the Workspace (one at the time) that you are interested in and click on *Download* to install it locally. When we publish a new workspace, you will see it available for download (in red) in the *Workspace manager* list.
