**Agenda item 3: Global Thematic Event on the CFS Framework for action on  
food security and nutrition in protracted crises**

Thank you Mr. Chairperson

Thailand thanks all stakeholders for sharing their experiences in implementing the CFS Framework.

We appreciate to learn that the eleven principles of the CFS Framework provide-meaningful guidance for application in a wide range of emergency and crisis situations, and support the humanitarian-development –peace nexus.

We think that monitoring and analysis of adoption, and use of CFS framework and other CFS policy guidance are very important tools to measure progress on ‘Zero Hunger’ targets, especially in the context of Covid-19 pandemic and beyond.

We agree that the CFS Framework needs to be further disseminated and implemented at the local and national level, so we reiterate the important role of the Rome-Based Agencies to work with the member countries in promoting awareness of CFS products, by providing training, and translating the products into local languages.
