*Thank you, Mr. Chairperson,
Excellencies, Ladies and Gentlemen,*

1. Indonesia commends the role of CFS as the UN's foremost inclusive inter-governmental platform in promoting policy changes to address current dynamic challenges, especially in food security and nutrition.
2. UNFSS 2021 delivers a strong message that we need to transform our global agri-food systems to achieve the 2030 SDGs.
3. Indonesia reaffirms its commitments to implement and to achieve the SDGs and food systems transformation.
4. In this context:
 - a. Strengthening the agriculture sector and supporting small-scale farmers are crucial for food systems transformation;
 - b. Recognize that specific steps to transform food systems needs to be tailored according to the local and regional context and one-size-fits-all approach should be avoided.

- c. Food systems transformation calls for more inclusive and stronger multi-stakeholder collaborative partnerships.
 - d. Food systems transformation is to create better and more healthy diets, equitable, inclusive, sustainable and resilient; and
5. Indonesia is also committed to increase international cooperation and partnership at any level to strengthen its agri-food systems.
 6. Indonesia further aims to use its 2022 G-20 presidency to promote concrete collaboration and to create transformation for better food systems.
 7. We hope CFS will develop a mechanism for international collaboration, share learning and capacity building, support implementation and monitoring, and mobilize resources to implement the Commitment to Actions of UNFSS 2021, as appropriate and based on and within its existing mandates, mechanisms and programme of work.
