## SWITZERLAND - STATEMENT

## Part II: Update of the rolling section of the CFS MYPoW 2020-2023

- We are looking forward to start the preparation of the draft MYPoW 2024-2027 and the launch of the HLPE Report on Reducing inequalities for food security and nutrition in 2023. [As highlighted, we consider the topic of urban and periurban food systems, as well as revitalizing climate for food security and nutrition as especially relevant and request to include them in the MYPoW 2024-2027.]
- We further suggest the selection of the CFS Policy Recommendations on Price Volatility (2011) and biofuels (2013) for the monitoring event during CFS51. This due to the current food crisis and the related challenges in the markets and energy sectors.
- Finally, Mr. Chair, the continuation of the CFS gender process leading to the adoption of the CFS Voluntary Guidelines on Gender Equality and Women's and Girls Empowerment in the Context of Food Security and Nutrition (VG on GEWGE) at CFS 51 should be part of the CFS MYPoW in 2022/2023.
- With these comments we can endorse the rolling section of the CFS MYPoW 2020-2023.
