

CFS Advisory Group – Extension

1. Following the CFS44 decision, in the context of the CFS Evaluation, to review the functions and composition of the Advisory Group in order for it to fulfil its substantive role;
2. Taking into account (i) the outcomes of the inclusive consultation process on this topic, (ii) the proposals to review the composition and the processes of the Advisory Group which have been received, and (iii) all relevant comments submitted to the CFS Secretariat;
3. Considering the initial appointment of the Advisory Group expired in March 2018, and later it was extended until July 2018;
4. Reminding that the Bureau will meet in September to conclude its discussion on the functions and composition of the Advisory Group;
5. The CFS Bureau is expected to take the following decision on 25 July:
 - a) ***To extend the mandate of the Advisory Group until CFS46, or until a decision has been made on the composition of the Advisory Group in the context of the implementation of the Recommendation 4 of the CFS Evaluation (whichever comes first).***
