

**CFS Multi-Year Programme of Work (MYPoW) for 2020-2023**  
**First Draft**

**PSM comments**

With regard to “Data collection and analysis tools” the PSM, as previously stated, believes sound, and scientifically based data and metrics are essential for developing the right policy choices and programme interventions. Nevertheless, this is a perspective which needs to be part of all MYPoW initiatives and CFS work rather than a specific topic. Therefore we would propose that the MYPoW 2020-23 be developed with data collection and analysis as a cross-cutting theme and interventions be highlighted in the proposals going forward that require a specific effort to develop the needed data base/analysis for the work, including how to approach privacy of data.

More generally, with regard to the overall MYPoW and proposals, the PSM remains committed to supporting the proposed workstreams on youth and gender but, in line with the CFS evaluation findings, remains cautious about CFS developing workstreams without the needed funding support as well as the more broader resource requirements needed from all stakeholders to ensure strong CFS products, that are well developed and would have an impact at country level, as an outcome.
