

Subject: Call for Inputs – CFS Policy Convergence on Building Resilient Food Systems

Dear CFS Stakeholders,

It is both an honor and a pleasure to reach out to you in my capacity as Rapporteur for the CFS Policy Convergence Process on Building Resilient Food Systems, launched at CFS 53. The session included a presentation of the main findings of the <u>HLPE-FSN Report</u> and an open discussion, the highlights of which are reflected in paragraph 24 v. of the CFS 53 <u>final report</u>.

CFS 53 also provided an important opportunity to collectively reaffirm the value of ensuring that **CFS policy products** are **concrete, concise, user-friendly and actionable**. - 1. **Priority Issues:** What key issues should be addressed through the policy recommendations, bearing in mind the needs of potential users and implementers at national and local levels? (500-word limit)
- 2. **Complementary Elements:** Are there additional elements or considerations that should be integrated to complement the analysis and recommendations presented in the HLPE-FSN Report? (500-word limit)
- 3. Practical Examples: Building on the Action Plan to Strengthen the Uptake of CFS Policy Products and on the "boxes" provided in the HLPE-FSN report, could you share one concrete case study from your country or constituency that illustrates how the forthcoming policy recommendations might be applied in practice? (500-word limit)

Please send your inputs to **cfs@fao.org** by **1 December COB**. Following this deadline, all contributions will be made available on the CFS Working Space to inform discussions at the first meeting of the Open-Ended Working Group, scheduled for **17 December**.
