Could you share your expectations in terms of desired outcomes and areas of work of this CFS workstream?

- The outcome will be concise, straightforward, action-oriented and concrete
- The outcome will be user-friendly
- The outcome will be non-repetitive and non-duplication of the previous or on-going CFS policy products
- The outcome should also set guidelines on increasing awareness, ownership, use and usefulness of future CFS policy outcomes

- **Areas of work** will elaborate more on how to harmonize, synchronize and apply the previous CFS policy product into action which will be breakdown as follows:
 - a. Global means of implementation (multilateral approach)
 - b. Regional means of implementation (regional approach)
 - c. National means of implementation (National action plan/country ownerships)
- 2. Could you indicate the main elements that would be important to include in the Action Plan?
 - **Integrated approach:** all efforts at global, regional and national level would be in line and implementable
 - **Multilaterally agreed concepts and implementation:** there should be no overlapping between the agreements at multilateral levels and CFS as well as national level
 - **Voluntary assessments and monitoring systems:** this approach so as to invite more countries to share their experiences and best practices at national level
- 3. Could you present concrete examples of uptake activities carried out by your constituency, including indications on their impact, challenges encountered as well as areas for improvement?
 - The focal point of CFS (Ministry of Agriculture) to share and disseminate all agreed CFS policies to all relevant ministries for their implementation (**impact: awareness**)
 - Adoption of CFS policy products (fully or partly) to national regulation (**impact: improvement in regulation**)
 - Harmonization of agreed CFS policy products to relevant ministries policy and programs (impact: tailor-made programs and targeted-policy focuses)
