IFAD is pleased to review the draft outline of the Action Plan and provide some initial feedback.

The below highlighted parts are the additions that IFAD suggests for the paragraphs indicated under section 3 of the outline:

- 3.B.4 - Regular awareness raising sessions to inform UN staff on CFS activities and agreements and strengthen linkages and development of uptake activities involving relevant UN actors at national level (e.g. UN Resident Coordinators, UN/RBAs country and HQ staff);
- 3.B.5 - Development of uptake activities and tools to promote the use of CFS policy products, agreements and recommendations at national and local levels (e.g. in collaboration with UN technical units and country representatives, UN Resident Coordinators, etc. but also national and local stakeholders in development activities);
- 3.B.8 - Guidance on expectations of how the Rome-based Agencies and other UN agencies should use CFS policy agreements (also based on expectations shared by Member States and other stakeholders).
