Ambassador Pio Wennubst is an agro-economist specialized in systemic approaches by training, has long experience in development diplomacy based on extensive field work in areas such as rural development, microfinance and public health. After a period as managing director of a Swiss chemical company, he moved to the public sector as an academic researcher. In 1992, he began working in the field of development cooperation for the UN in Nepal. He joined the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) in 1995 and was initially posted to Bolivia and subsequently to Madagascar where he was tasked with reorganizing Swiss development cooperation activities. After a period as an economist at the SDC's head office in Bern, in 2004 Pio Wennubst was appointed SDC country director in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania. From 2008 to 2011, he was the deputy permanent representative of the Swiss mission to the RBA's. From 2010, he was in charge of the SDC's Global Program Food Security. He later joined the Swiss permanent mission to the UN in New York as head of the economic and social development team. He later managed the Global Cooperation Department as assistant director general of the SDC. He is currently representing Switzerland to the RBA's. As of October 2021, he assumes the role of Rapporteur for the CFS in Promoting Youth Engagement and Employment in Agriculture and Food Systems.
