# Five different funding modalities

- Voluntary contributions to the **Global Trust Fund**
- **Bilateral agreement Resource Partner – FAO/ Regional Organization**
- Agreements between developing countries (**South - South cooperation agreements**)
- FAO resources from assessed contributions (**TCP Projects** and direct assistance)
- **Bilateral agreement Resource Partner- Country**



# Global Trust Fund and Administrative Agent

## ■ Global Trust Fund (GTF)

- Provides clear framework to donor contributions,
- Ensures a stream of funding to support implementation global, regional, and national levels

## ■ Administrative Agent (AA)

- Receives Resource Partner contributions
- Disburses funds to Participating Partners
- Consolidates reports prepared by PPs (progress and year end)
- AA function is separated and located in different units from those of other functions (e.g PP or Global PMTSU)



# Participating Partners (PPs)

---

All partners that will:

- Receive funds from the Administrative Agent
- Implement agreed activities
- Fully accountable for use of funds received
- Responsible for preparation of progress, year end and financial reports



# Participating Partners (PPs)

---

- **FAO Statistics Division** is a PP for global level activities
- Will receive funds from the AA
- FAO Statistics Division will host Global PMTSU



# Participating Partners (PPs) – Regional level

## ■ Africa

- **African Development Bank (AfDB)** is PP for regional and country level activities
- Regional Steering Committee and Secretariat established
- Resource partners can contribute to:
  - Global Trust Fund
  - Regional fund for Africa

## ■ Other Regions

- Assessment of other Regional Organizations to take responsibility as PP for country and/or regional activities ongoing
