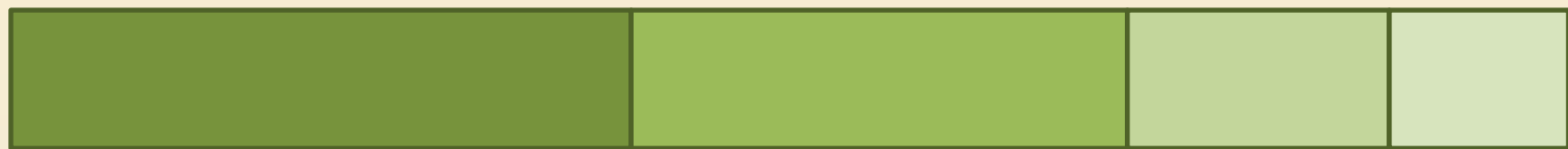

What is the purpose of the site?

- Outreach to: Donor agencies, Statistical agencies of member countries, Consultants for international organizations, and Methodologists of agricultural statistics
- Transparency: Better understand through visual and numerical indicators national agricultural system characteristics and how they compare with your neighbours
- Portal: Serves as a portal with web links and physical contact information to important statistical agencies in covered countries
- Resource page: Links to statistics methodologies for some key agricultural and rural statistics
- Scope: We are initially targeting to create personalized pages for 22 countries; inclusive of all APCAS members

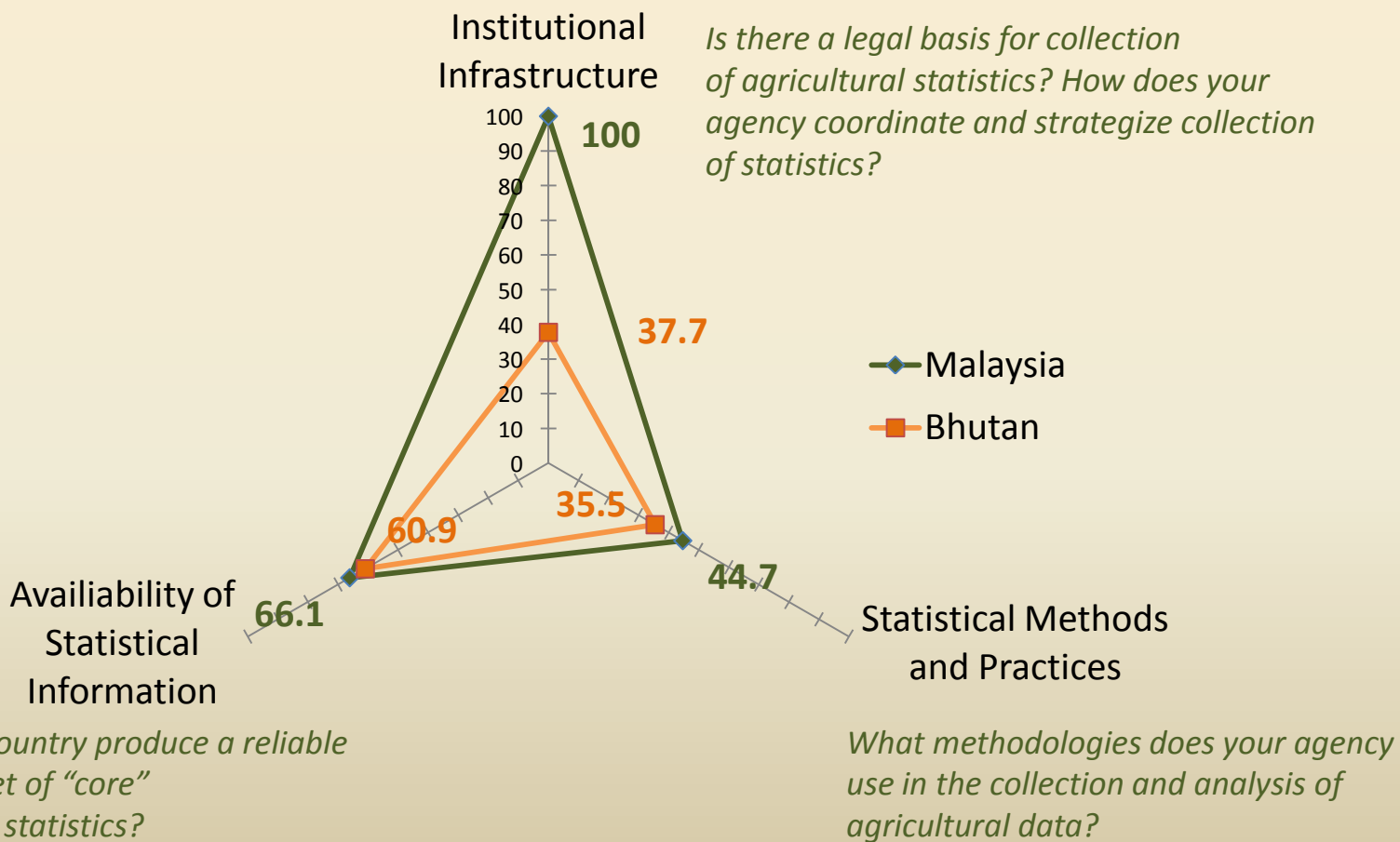

Structure of the Website and Visual Indicator Tools

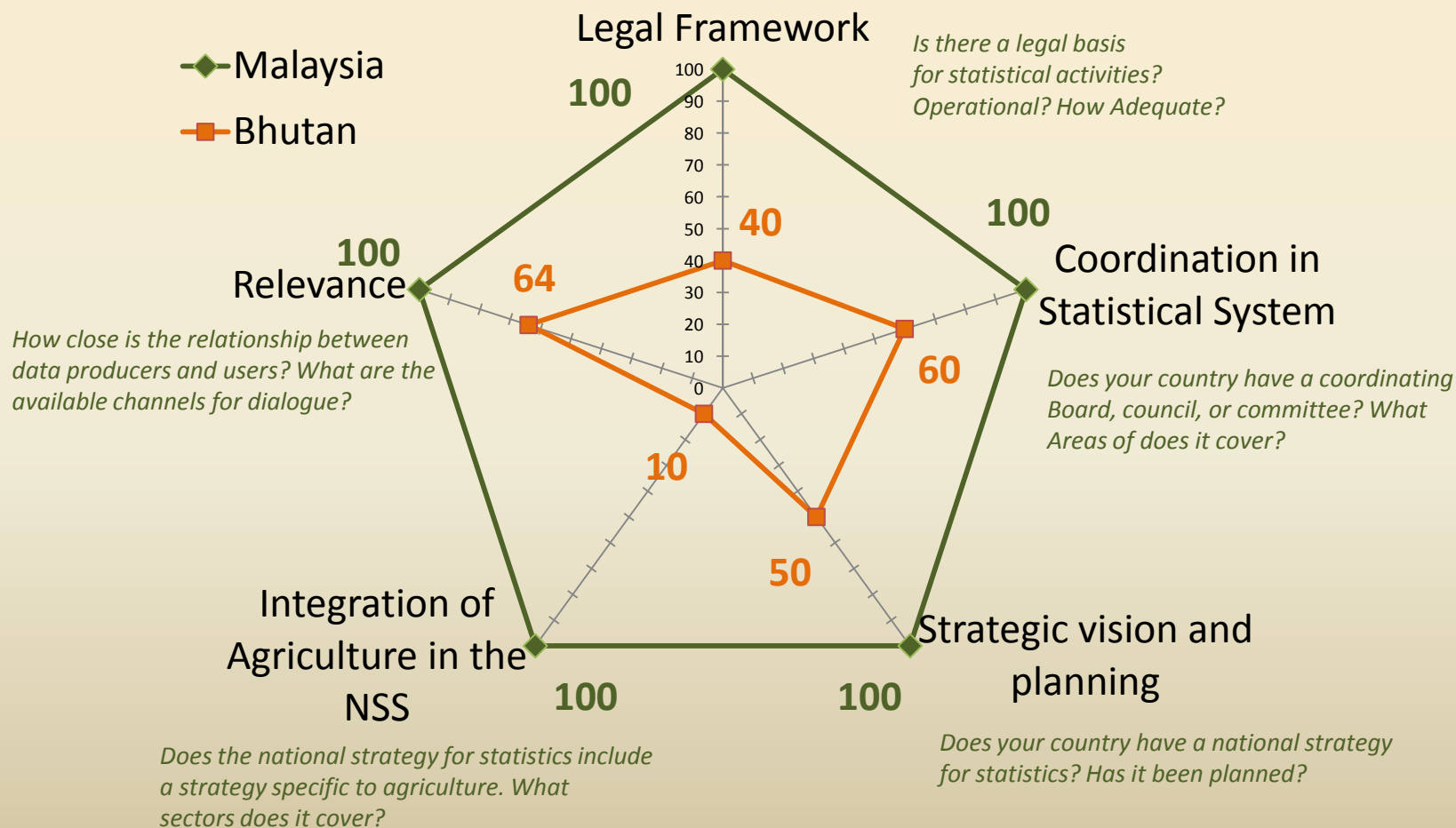

Statistical Software capability

Data Capture Technology

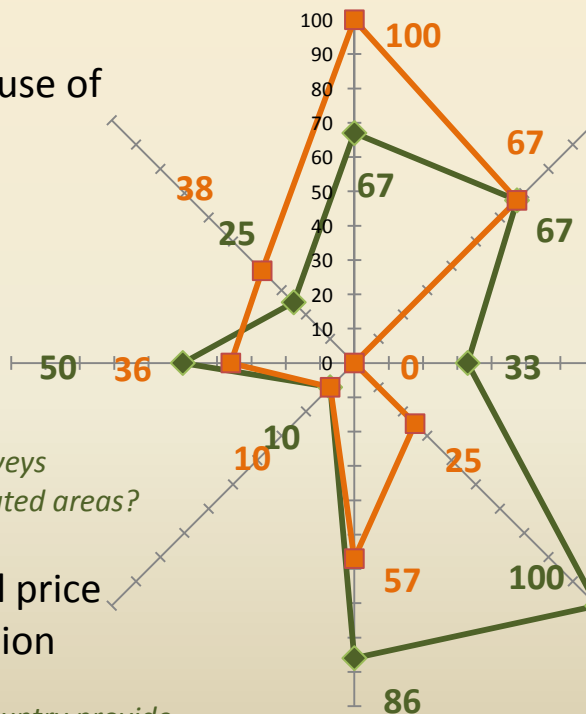
How does your agency collect data? Personal Interviews?

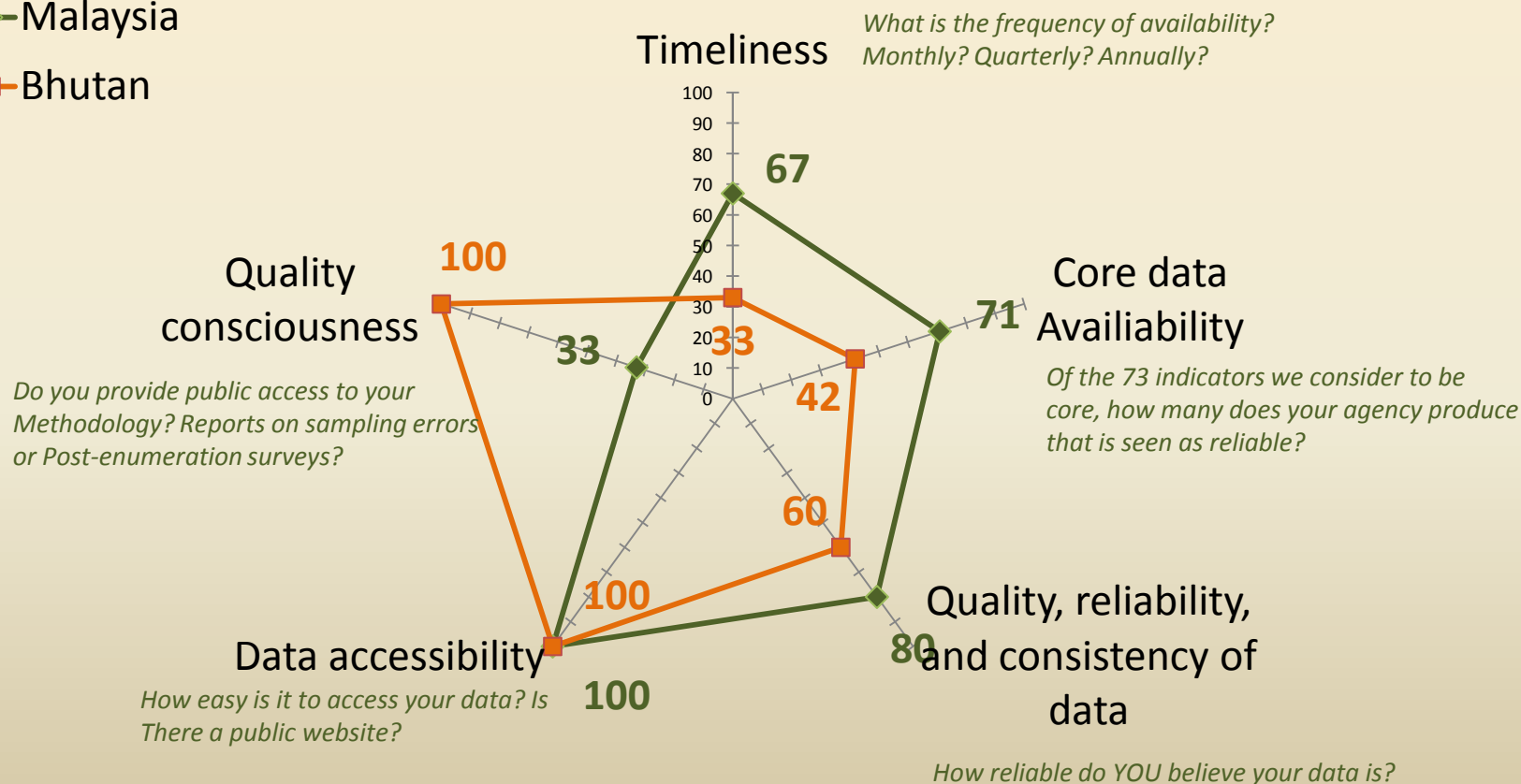

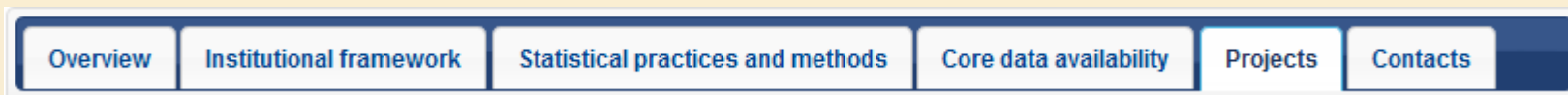

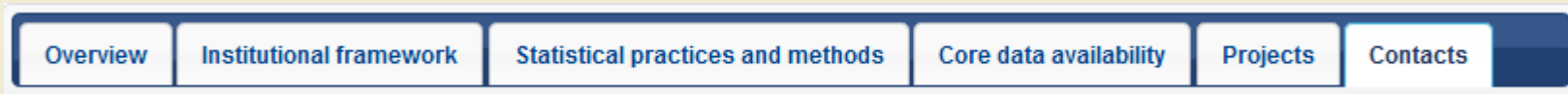
