Assume continuity for the information given to the participants so keep them updated for all news and activities concerning this subject.</li> <li>3. Choose other subjects for much deeper knowledge of the participants; Share more practical cases of other countries.</li> <li>4. FAO did the best workshop we remember.</li> <li>5. Additional training on calculation of indicators (estimation), with specialized software.</li> <li>6. To make more workshops like this to have a good experience and it is very beneficial.</li> <li>7. Treatment of non-response in sample survey should be covered in the agenda</li> <li>8. To hold similar workshops in other Arab Countries due to its importance to the statistical works.</li> <li>9. Holding Regular workshop on new findings in Agricultural Statistics and training member countries on statistics to improve Agricultural Statistics and facilitating international comparison.</li> </ol>

It was too charged.</li><li>4. The exercises will be better if use SPSS. Practical in sampling field for many users.</li><li>5. More technical information in this workshop on statistical approach.</li></ol>
