Practical B: Full agriculture census module for a linked population and housing , and agriculture censuses

Learning Objective

To identify data items relevant to users and potential questions for a full agriculture census module in a linked population and housing, and agriculture census for PICs.

Output

Prepare a 10 minute presentation discussing the key data items, questions and relevant issues for a **full agriculture census** module to be used in a linked census.

Activities

1. Which of the items in Annex 1 of the *Guidelines for linking population and housing with agricultural censuses* are relevant to data users in your countries?
2. Are there other key agricultural items not covered which would be suitable for a full agricultural module in a linked census? The items listed in SDS 11 of the World Programme for Agriculture may be referred to.
3. For selected items, develop questions which can be used to enumerate the selected data items.
4. What are some of the issues which would need to be addressed in your country when including a full agriculture census module in the population census.
5. What do you see as the main advantages and disadvantages of including a full agricultural census module in your census of population and housing
