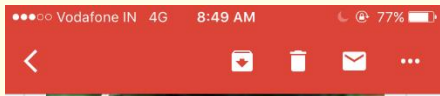

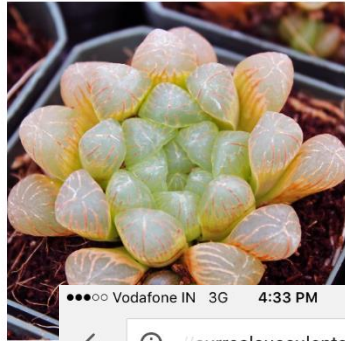

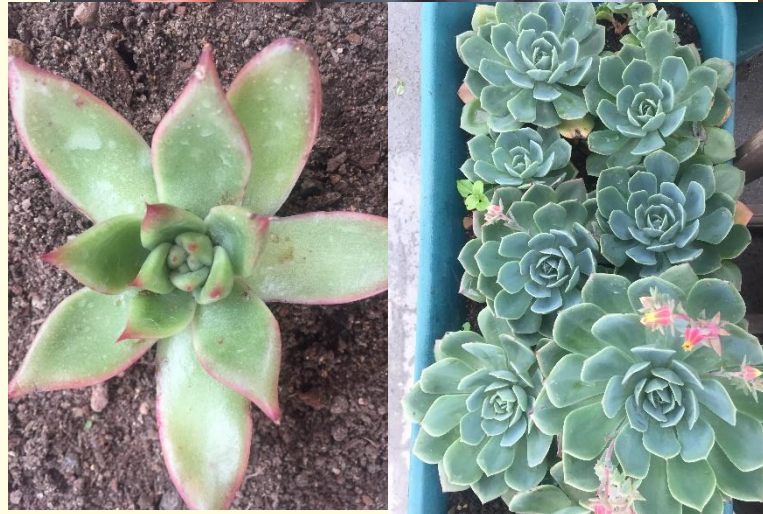

80% of the state is under forest cover

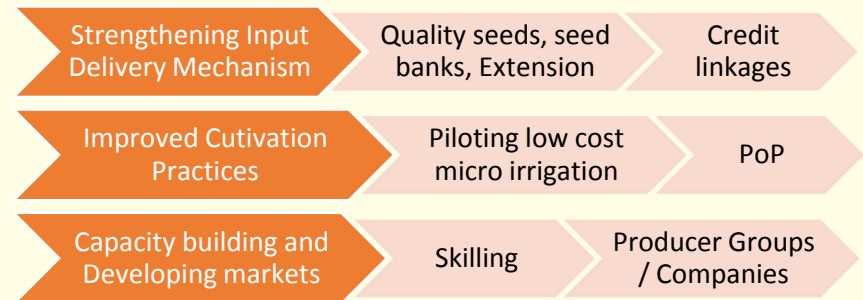


Predominantly rural with 71% of population living in villages
