

FAO reviews office in Asia-Pacific seeking to sharpen regional presence for greater impact with current resources



08/03/2016 Putrajaya, Malaysia – Following a brief presentation by Daniel Gustafson, FAO Deputy Director-General, Operations, FAO Member Countries today reviewed the Organization’s representation across the Asia and Pacific region.

Delegates at the 33rd Session of the FAO Regional Conference for Asia and the Pacific (APRC33), underway in Putrajaya, Malaysia 7-11 March, evaluated the efficacy of the FAO’s Decentralized Office Network, looking for the most cost-effective configurations to deliver agriculture, fisheries and forestry assistance across the vast region. There were interventions from eight countries during the conference session and one Civil Society Organization statement.
