

First Save Food Partners Meeting Convened in Thailand

Participants to a Save Food partners meeting convened by the FAO Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific FAO-RAP on 20 March 2014, agreed to collaborate in developing a National Save Food Network in Thailand (SFNET), in order to upscale and outscale the Save Food Campaign in Thailand.

Present at the meeting were representatives from the Food Science and Technology Association of Thailand, Thai Chamber of Commerce and Board of Trade of Thailand, Thai Food Processors Association, Thai Retailers Association, Thai Packaging Association and the Population and Community Development Association, along with FAO staff. The meeting also discussed the Save Food Asia-Pacific Campaign within the context of food losses and food waste in Thailand, outlined potential areas for collaboration and partnership to strengthen and broaden campaign activities across Thailand.
