# 1. FAO's mandate in Statistics

#### Article I – item 1

The Organization shall collect, analyse, interpret and disseminate information relating to nutrition, food and agriculture. In this **Constitution**, the term "agriculture" and its derivatives include fisheries, marine products, forestry and primary forestry products.

#### **Article IX**

All Member Nations and Associate Members shall also communicate regularly to the Director-General statistical, technical and other information published or otherwise issued by, or readily available to, the government.


# 2. Declining availability of Ag. Stats.

- Large Gaps in FAOSTAT, non-official data sources
- Outdated methodologies; non adoption of latest technological tools
- Subjective methods or administrative reporting systems
- Inadequate financial and human resources
- Diversity of administrative arrangements for statistical activities across countries.
- Weak institutional infrastructure
  - Overlapping roles and responsibilities
  - Lack of coordination
  - Absence of strategic planning to improve agricultural statistics on NSDS lines

#### ✓ BIG PUSH was needed to build national capacity to produce Agricultural Statistics

# 4. Domain of Agricultural Statistics

- Information (ad hoc or periodic; verbal or numeric)
- **Data** (traditionally numeric, Now digital also)
- **Reports** (some what structured; routine)
- Assessment (usually adhoc with some methodology)
- **Statistics** (quality statements)
- **Official Statistics** (Quality/reliability + independent source + established periodicity + assigned responsibility)




# 5. Global Strategy

- An initiative of the UNSC to be implemented in 90 countries in the world and 20 countries in Asia Pacific region over 5 years
- Developed through extensive consultation with international organizations, national stakeholders and NGSs
- Twin-track approach (NSO and MOA)
- Focus on Strategic Planning, Capacity Building, and Methodological Research



- Opportunities:
