### Title: SAARC Special Session on AMR

### Focal Point: Carolyn Benigno (FAO RAP ); MJH Jabed (SAARC Secretariat)

### **Background and justification:**

Use of antimicrobials in the livestock production industry for therapeutic, preventative, and growth promotion purposes across Asia is widespread. Weak or non-existent regulatory frameworks governing antimicrobial use, sub-optimal enforcement and compliance with existing guidelines, low levels of AMR awareness, and inadequate commitment to responsible antimicrobial stewardship are driving development of AMR. Regionally, AMR mitigation measures in the livestock production industry—from guidelines for prudent use of antimicrobials to monitoring antimicrobial usage (AMU) and enhancing AMR surveillance—lag behind the human health sector.

Key challenges in addressing AMU in the livestock production industry of relevance in Asia include following aspects: 1) Sector-specific considerations; 2) Policy, regulatory environment, and harmonization of standards; and 3) Advocacy, awareness raising and compliance.

In consideration of the complex and nuanced operating environment driving AMU and AMR in the livestock production industry in Asia, a multi-track approach is essential to promoting responsible AMU stewardship. During the SAARC CVO Meeting held in Kathmandu, Nepal FAO presented its regional initiatives on AMR control and the FAO regional project on AMR which aims to promote a more prudent use of antimicrobial in the livestock production industry in Asia leading to minimizing the likelihood of AMR development and spread.

The SAARC CVO Meeting agreed to support the initiatives and agreed to convene a special session on AMR . As a follow up from the decision at the 3<sup>rd</sup> ASEAN National Focal Points in Veterinary Products (ANFPVP) 4-5 April 2016, in Ha Noi, Viet Nam, a special session on AMR and a meeting to finalize the ANFPVP Plan of Action will be convened in Singapore during the period 11 – 13 July 2016.

#### **Objectives/Outcomes** :

- 1. To brief the Meeting on the progress of the FAO Initiatives on AMR and other initiatives from other partners
- 2. To develop a SAARC Call For Action on SAARC Cooperation Activities for Antimicrobial Resistance
- 3. To discuss and develop a set of regional interventions to move/develop the National Action Plans on AMR
