

Location





- Parties:

- Local community: co-management board
- Government agency: Communes PPCs
- Auditor: Mangrove Ecosystem Research Center; District forest ranger.
- Activities:
- Forest protection and enrichment
- Mangrove base livelihood improvement activities
- Develop benefit sharing mechanism

Bang La – Dai Hop

- Implementation modalities:
- Financiers sign agreement with comanagement board.
- Implement benefit sharing mechanism
- Initial steps:
- Co-management Board establish
- Develop forest protection and benefit sharing mechanism.

Tien Hai district Thai Binh province

- 5 communes
- 1,200 ha of mangroves
- 12,000 ha of total area

Rational

- Mangrove degradation of natural cycle
- Economic dynamic development

Parties

- Financier: International financier
- Local partners: Mangrove conservation board of Tien Hai, Commune/District People Committees, co-management groups; tourism companies, aquaculture businesses
- Auditor: MERC, forest rangers

Proposed Activities

- Mangrove protection
- Mangrove-based aquaculture
- Mangrove restoration
- Eco-tourism/birds watch
- Co-mangrove management

Tien Hai Implementation modalities

- Establish Village Co-management Groups (VCG)
- Establish Commune Co-management Boards (CCB)
- Strengthen Conservation Board of Tien Hai
- The potential financier will sign agreement with the Conservation Board of Tien Hai
- The Conservation Board of Tien Hai will sign agreements with CCB and VCG to implement

Initial steps for project proposal

- Share project idea with the Conservation management board of Tien Hai
- Initial Assessment of resources and capacities
- Support the Conservation management board of Tien Hai to develop project proposal

Binh Dai District

- Parties:
- Financier: Initial financing from international donor, to develop viable business model and technical support. Main financiers are aquaculture processing companies.
- TAB: IUCN
- Local community: Ben Tre Forest Management Board
- Government agency: Ben Tre Department of Agriculture and Rural Development
- Auditor: International aquaculture certificate
- Activities
- Restore mangrove to reach the national regulations to meet environmental requirement of organic aquatic products
- Get eco-friendly aquatic product certificate to increase the revenue of processing companies.

Binh Dai District

- Implementation modalities
- Organize households into eco-friendly aquaculture groups.
- Business engagement to call for private sector investment
- Certify eco-friendly aquatic products.
- Monitor the sustainability of business model and possibility of expansion.
- Initial steps:
- Support provincial forestry and fishery agencies on proposal preparation
- Approval and support from local government.
- Setup payment mechanism.

Mui Ca Mau National Park

- Parties
- Financiers: Provincial authority, SP-RECC, UN-REDD Programme, ICMP (GIZ),
- TAB: DARD, VNFREST
- Local communities: National Park FMB
- Audit: PFPD, DARD, DONRE
- Activities
- Technical and financial support to improve local livelihood,
- ➤ Alternative income generation: eg. Eco tourism, improved fishery equipment
- Legal framework for co-management
- Patrol equipment for the NP
- Coastal protection dike against erosion (Government budget)
- Chemical wast management
- > Strengthenning public wareness, communication

- Technical support by DARD, DONRE
- Agreement the NP and local communities
- Initial steps
- Proposal development by NP FMB
- Networking and communication with relevant stakeholders, including local authorities, communities, programmes/projects and other possible donors
