

FAO RESPONSE

The FAO Secretariat thanks the Government of the Republic of Indonesia for its comments on agenda item 5.

Indonesia's intention to contribute to the FAO Action Plan on AMR 2021-2025 and to participate in the pilot testing of the Progressive Management Pathway for Improving Aquaculture Biosecurity (PMP/AB) are duly noted.

FAO appreciates the active engagement and support of Indonesia to the implementation of project "Improving Biosecurity Governance and Legal Framework for Efficient and Sustainable Aquaculture Production" (GCP/GLO/979/NOR).

The FAO Secretariat appreciates Indonesia's support for the holding of the Global Conference on Aquaculture Millennium +20, encouragement for the finalization of Guidelines on Sustainable Aquaculture, and welcoming of the report on *The State of the World's Aquatic Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture*. The FAO Secretariat acknowledges the request for FAO assistance to develop national management plans on aquatic genetic resources, which is consistent with the objectives of the draft Global Plan of Action on which FAO will be ready to provide support, subject to available resources. FAO advises that this request be initially addressed to the FAO Representation Office in Jakarta for appropriate action.
