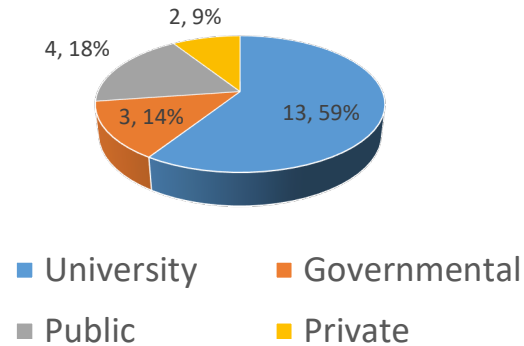

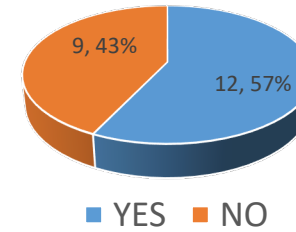

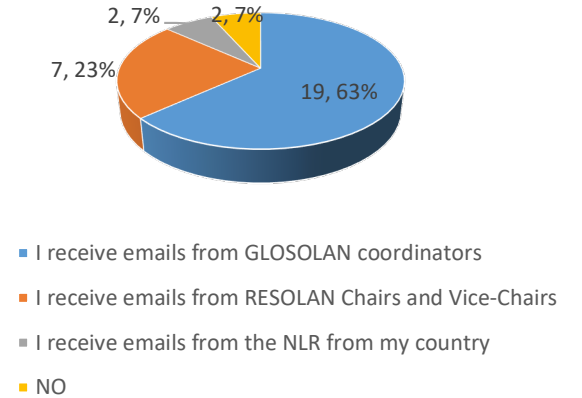
Type of laboratories

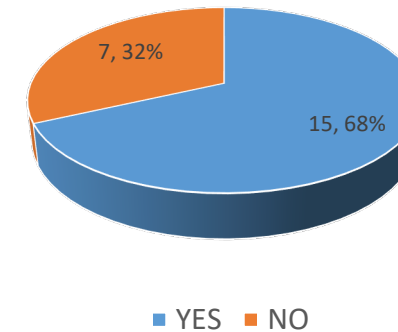

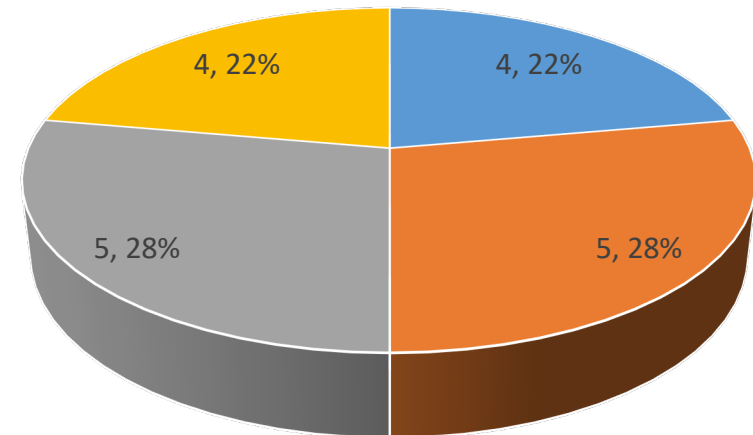

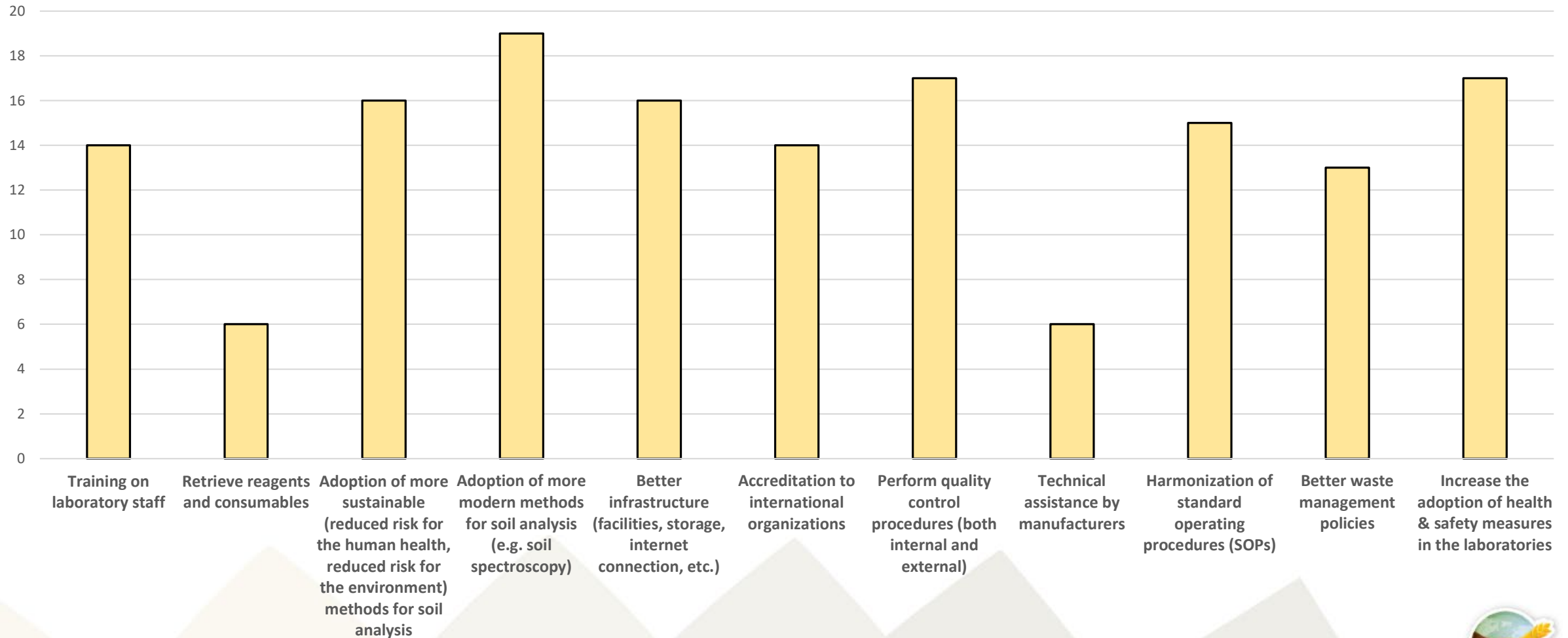

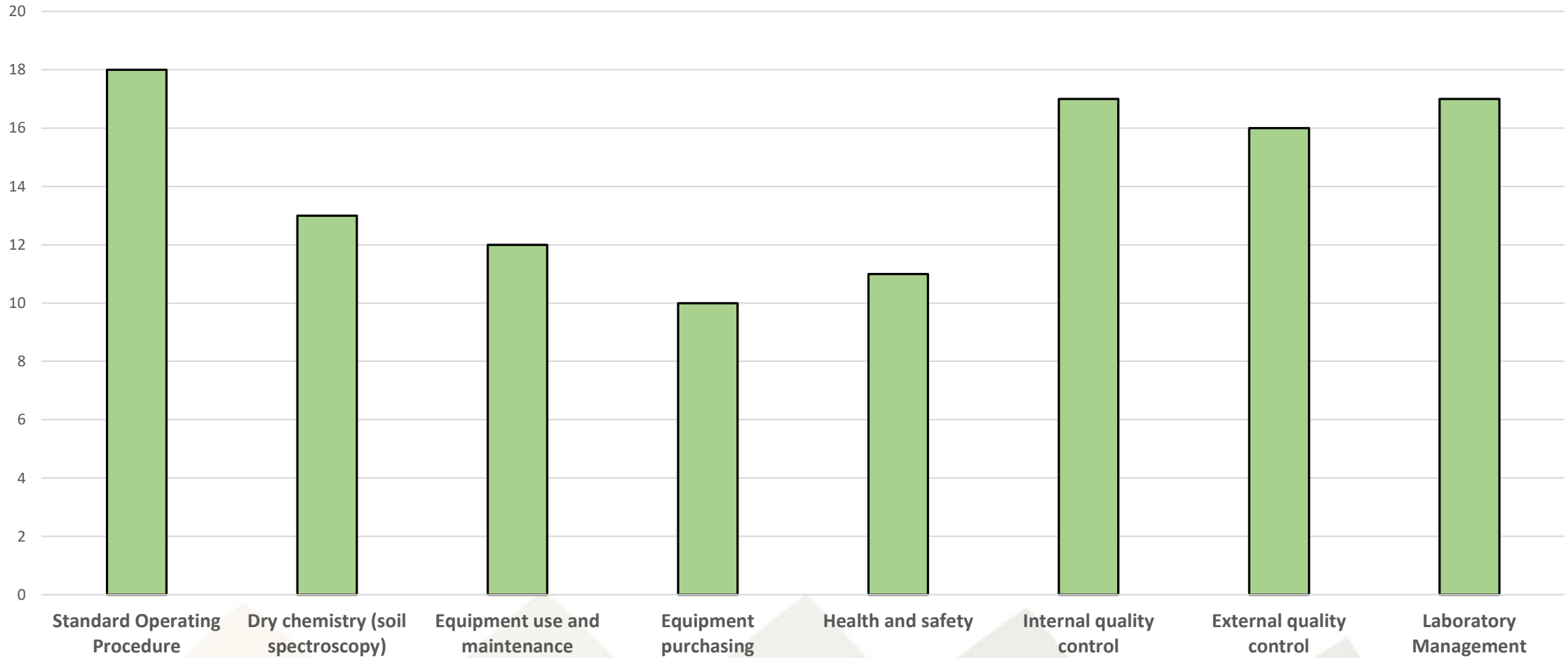

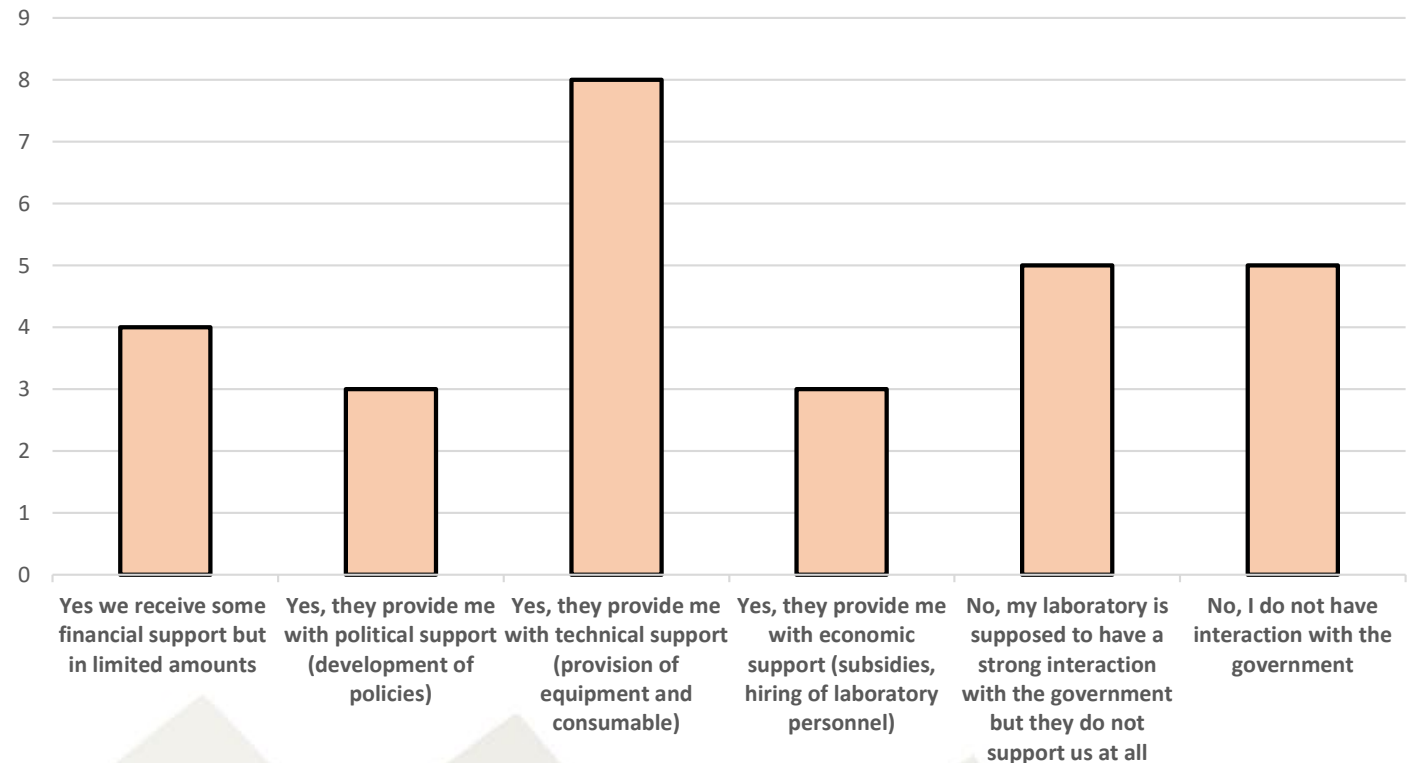


Awareness and support from the national and regional governments
