- 5. More inclusive value chains, engagement of private sector


Southern Indus Basin, Pakistan (ASSIB)

Landscape – Pakistan

Vast alluvial plain formed over millions of years in bed of the Indus River and its major tributaries

Three rivers feeding into Indus (Sutlej, Ravi, Beas) have been dammed by India

Water security is a strategic issue




Landscape – Mekong

Multinational river

Rises in the Tibetan Plateau (China)

Flows through China, Myanmar, Thailand, Laos, Cambodia and Vietnam



Landscape – Ganges & Brahmaputra Rivers

Farming on islands in the delta of the Lhasa Yarlung Zangbo (Tsangpo) two rivers. Adjacent to a world heritage natural Kathmand forest (Sundarbans). Amount of water that flows into Bangladesh has been constrained by increasing use of Ganges by India. Bay of Bengal


Water security is a strategic issue

For each of these river systems...

River flows are highly seasonal...

Seawater intrudes up the water-ways in the dry seasons...

Causes major problems for irrigation and coastal communities


Rainfall & irrigation

Rainfall is higher in Vietnam (e.g. Can Tho)...

...than Bangladesh (e.g. Khulna)

...and southern Pakistan (e.g. Sujawal).

Groundwater

Important as source of irrigation and drinking water especially in southern Pakistan and Bangladesh

Concerns

Groundwater is limited resource

Can lead to soil sodicity and salinity in Pakistan




Salinity – Bangladesh & West Bengal

Seasonal seawater intrusion; shallow water-tables

Land lies fallow in rabi-season

Impoverishes communities

Salinity – Pakistan

South of the country ~40% of irrigated land affected
North of country ~25% of irrigated land affected


Salt added to land in irrigation water (surface & groundwater)

Associated with sodicity and seepage (= shallow water-tables)

Impoverishes communities




Salinity – Vietnam






Climate change is coming
