Endorsement of the mission, objectives and goals

1. **Soil Pollution Assessment-** Harmonizing laboratory methods (SOPs) for the measurement of soil contaminants, collaboration with GLOSOLAN
2. **Soil Pollution Mapping-** generation of a spatial dataset on the distribution of soil pollution/ identifying “hot spots”. Collaboration with INSII
3. **Monitoring and regulation of polluted soils-** establishment of regulatory frameworks and compliance. Development of targets and indicators that can be included in national voluntary commitments on sustainable development
4. **Sustainable management and Remediation-** collection and dissemination of sustainable management and remediation practices and technologies for polluted soil, with special emphasis on nature-based solutions. Collaboration with NETSOB

- Maintain active communication with established organizations and networks dealing with soil pollution and advocate for their inclusion and participation in the INSOP

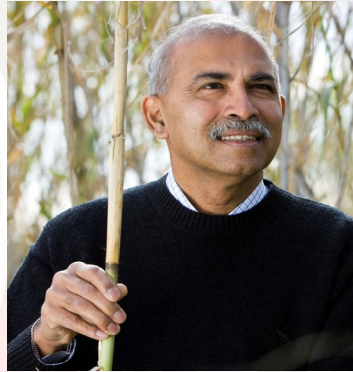
Endorsement of the TOR's for Chair and Vice-Chair

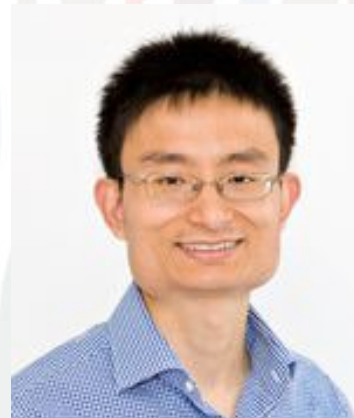
