Historically **high input prices** have been driven by the current global challenges

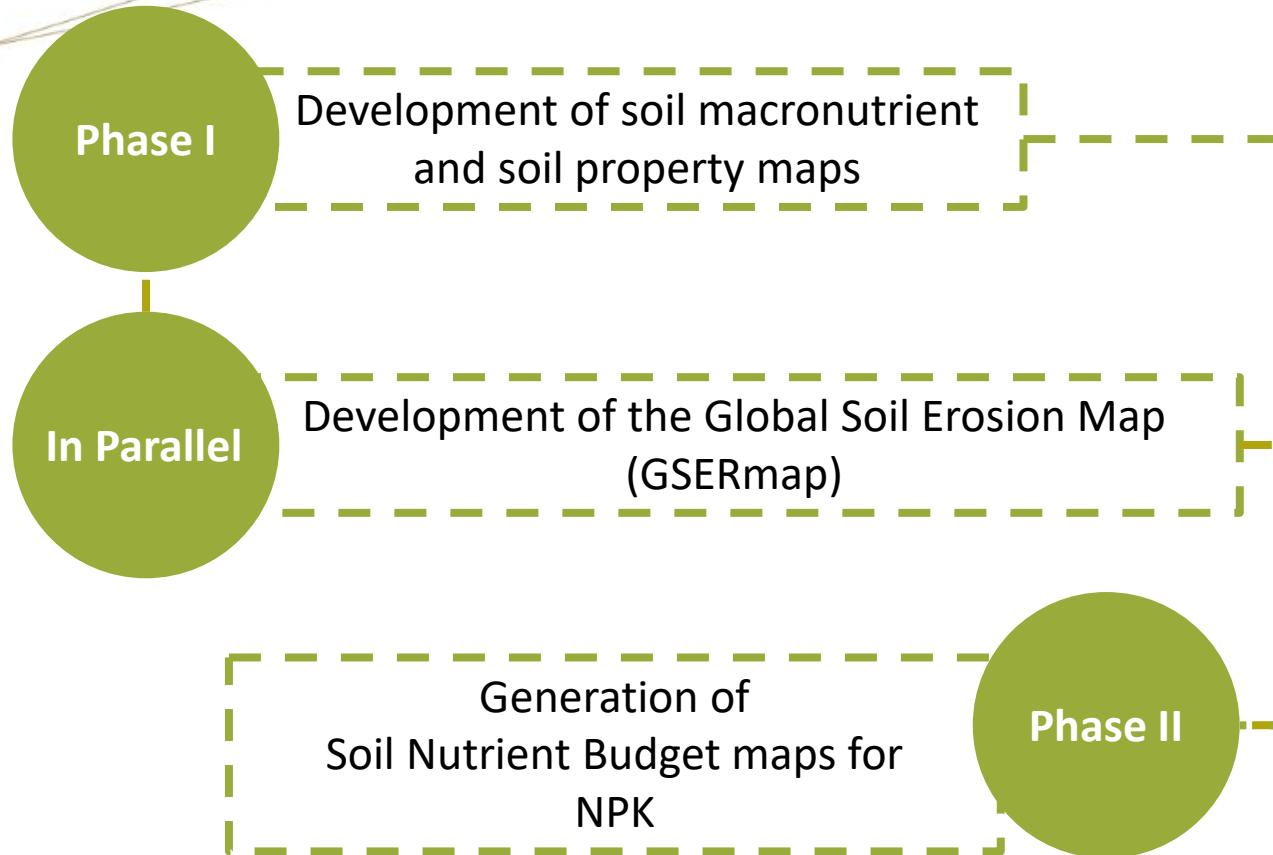
Data-driven management solutions are needed to boost farmer resilience

GSNmap – Two phase approach:



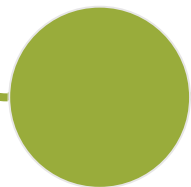

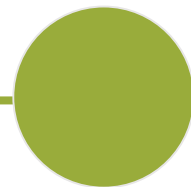

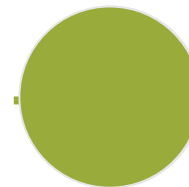
