Title: Extrapolation of maximum residue limits of veterinary drugs to one or more species

Description of work The EWG should:

- Continue work on extrapolation to edible offal tissues other than liver and kidney, and in line with the discussions at CCRVDF27,
 - ensure any approach for extrapolation to edible offal tissues other than liver and kidney should incorporate a residue intake calculation conducted by the EWG to demonstrate safety for the consumer;
 - o consider exploring data sources used by JMPR and JECFA to consider an estimated consumption value of other edible offal; and
 - utilize available distribution data in animals to confirm that the most appropriate tissue to extrapolate is the standard tissue with the highest MRL and assess the likelihood of compliance with the proposed extrapolated value.
- Consider any nominations for extrapolations that may be received under Part V of the
 priority list using the established extrapolation criteria. The EWG may consider proposing
 enhancements to the criteria as appropriate.

<u>Note</u>: To assist the EWG in its endeavors, it is recommended that Codex Members submit available consumption data for edible offal to the <u>FAO GIFT</u> and <u>WHO CIFOCOss</u> databases.

and consideration by CCRVDF28 (2026) three months in advance of the plenary session.
