Description of work	<p>CCFH 55 agreed to establish an EWG to</p> <p>i. continue the structural alignment of Codex texts with the revised General Principles of Food Hygiene (CXC 1-1969). The alignment work should prioritize the work on the:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) <i>Code of hygienic practice for the transport of food in bulk and semi-packed food</i> (CXC 47-2001);b) <i>Code of hygienic practice for bottled/package drinking waters (other than natural mineral waters)</i>(CXC 48-2001); andc) <i>Code of hygienic practice for collecting, processing and marketing of natural mineral waters</i> (CXC 33-1985). <p>ii. document the alignment approach through the decision tree or other means;</p> <p>iii. integrate the alignment work plan with the committee's forward work plan to ensure consistency in CCFH's work planning; and</p> <p>iv. submit a report with the proposed aligned texts, refined decision tree, updated forward work plan, and other possible recommendations on next steps.</p>
