 Develop a complementary guideline containing guidance for actions that competent authorities could take upon detection of residues of veterinary drugs in food of animal origin caused by unavoidable and unintentional carryover of veterinary drugs in animal feed

 Develop Action Levels as approved on the priority list in line with the procedure within Annex D of the Risk Analysis Principles applied by CCRVDF

comments and consideration by CCRVDF28 (2026) three months in advance of the plenary

session.
