Title: Joint EWG between CCRVDF and CCPR

Committee Codex Committee on Residues of Veterinary Drugs in Foods (CCRVDF) and

Codex Committee on Pesticide Residues (CCPR)

**Description of work** The EWG will continue to identify and prioritize issues affecting both committees and

recommend ways to address the issues and to inform CAC accordingly.

In particular, the EWG will:

 Develop a list of compounds with dual use as a pesticide and veterinary drug for which no or only one Codex MRL has been established with member countries providing the information to populate this list.

- Identify dual-use compounds that have different Codex MRLs for a similar edible commodity of animal origin and recommend on a case-by-case basis, a single, harmonized MRL(s) for the compound(s) and affected commodity(ies). The EWG might recommend that CCRVDF/CCPR consider selecting the higher MRL value.
- Consider the matter related to harmonized food descriptors to be used by JECFA and JMPR.

**Note**: This EWG was established by CAC44 (2021) to facilitate work between CCPR and CCRVDF on issues of common interest to both committees notably to enable the establishment of harmonized/ single MRLs for compounds with dual uses to the extent possible.

Codex Contact Points are invited to share this invitation with their <u>veterinary</u> <u>services and plant protection offices</u> to facilitate coordination at national level and, if possible, to appoint delegates that represent the two services to facilitate discussion in this EWG.

**Timetable for work** Updates on findings on the matters identified in the mandate of the EWG will be

provided to CCPR55 and CCRVDF27 within two months before the respective plenary meetings. The Joint EWG will continue its work as long as both CCRVDF and CCPR

consider it useful.
