











Regional FMD Virus Pools






No. Country per PCP Stage (Total= 57)

Top Regional Priorities

- 1. Raise awareness on disease recognition and timely reporting
- 2. Surveillance (passive/active)
- 3. Accurate and timely diagnosis of FMD
- 4. Regional laboratory and epidemiology networks
- 5. Vaccine matching and quality
- 6. Cross border and regional coordination and harmonization on surveillance, control and share of information
- 7. Combine control of FMD with other livestock diseases
- 8. Funding
