 - Coordinated the Global Tuna Atlas TWG;
 - Contributed to the 7th session of the FIRMS e-Technical Working Group on the Global Record of Stocks and Fisheries (GRSF);
 - Contributed to the questionnaire on the consolidation on FIRMS terminology;
- 4. Development of Applications (e.g., new module at Secretariat level, or enhancements in streamlining workflow at Partner level)

 - The IOTC data coordinator and the IOTC stock assessment experts continued to familiarise with current FIRMS reporting requirements although no formal training was conducted on the matter;

 - Continue supporting the Global Tuna Atlas TWG.
