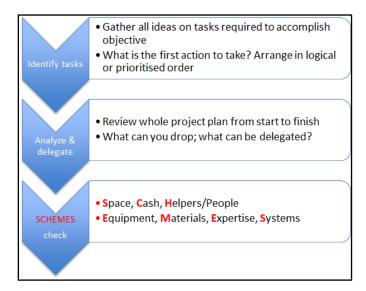
A roadmap is required both for new policies, programmes, initiatives, and budgets, and for integration of actions into existing one ones. Crucially, it allows the project team to identify which stakeholders need to be engaged to pave the way towards putting the action in place, and to develop appropriate outreach activities.
