The High-Level Event “Step It Up Together with Rural Women to End Hunger and Poverty” will offer an interactive platform for Members, UN entities, the international community, civil society and other stakeholders to address the structural causes and consequences of gender inequality in rural areas. It will also provide the opportunity to identify the main challenges, gaps, opportunities and collaborative actions for unleashing the potential of rural women and girls to end food insecurity, malnutrition and poverty.
