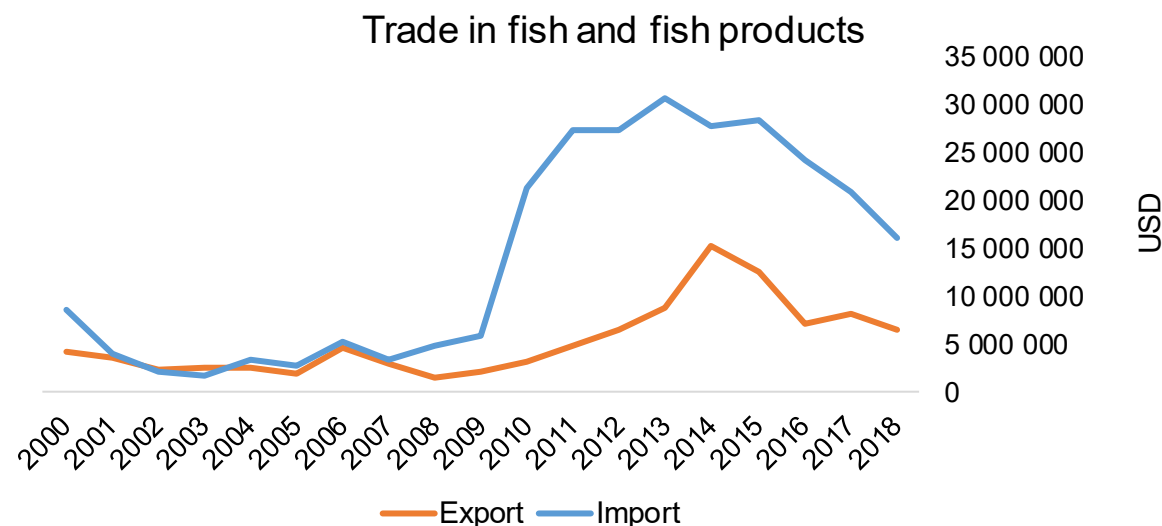

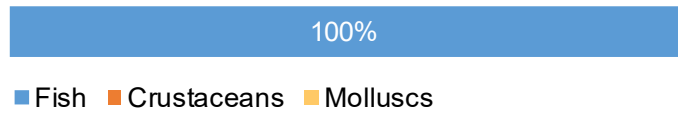

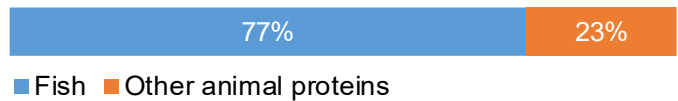

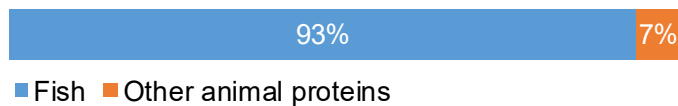
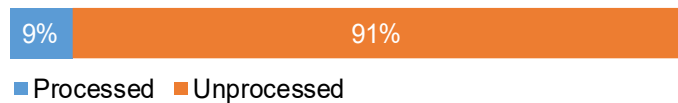
Production by volume
