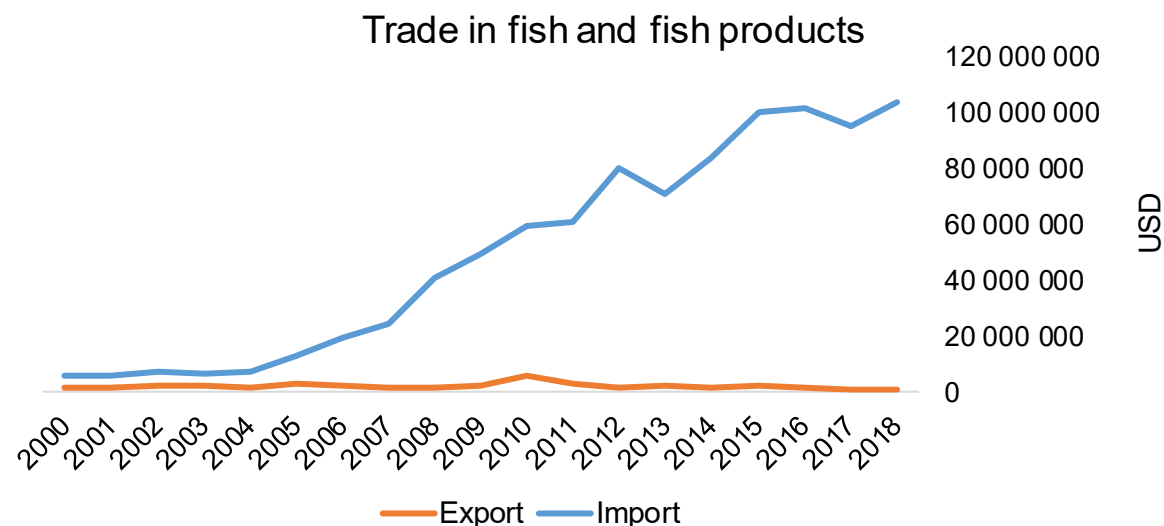

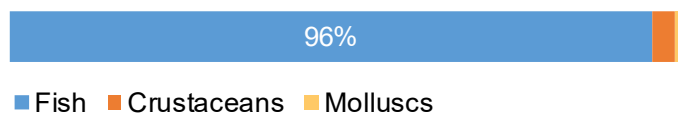

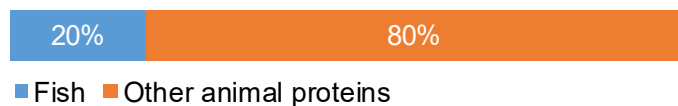
Production by volume
