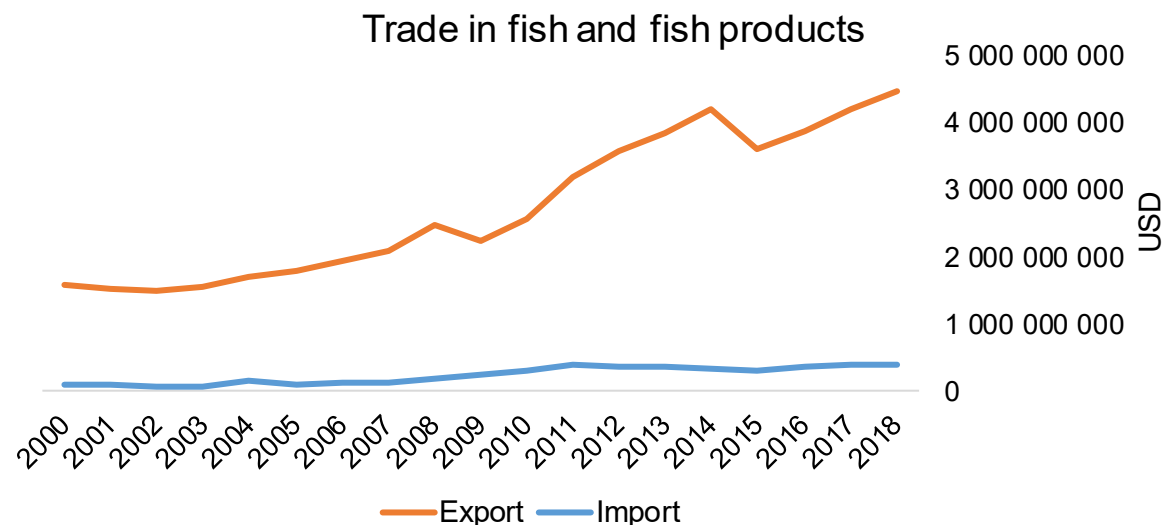

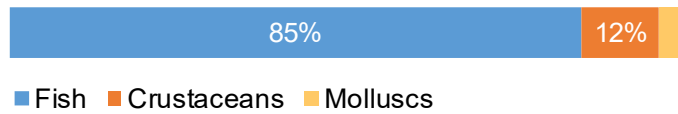

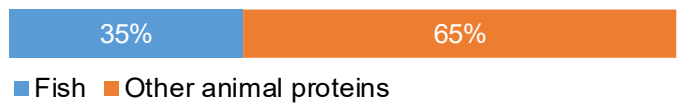

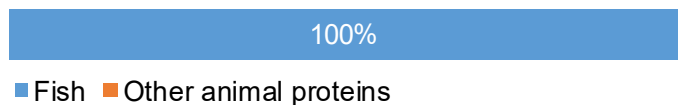
Production by volume
