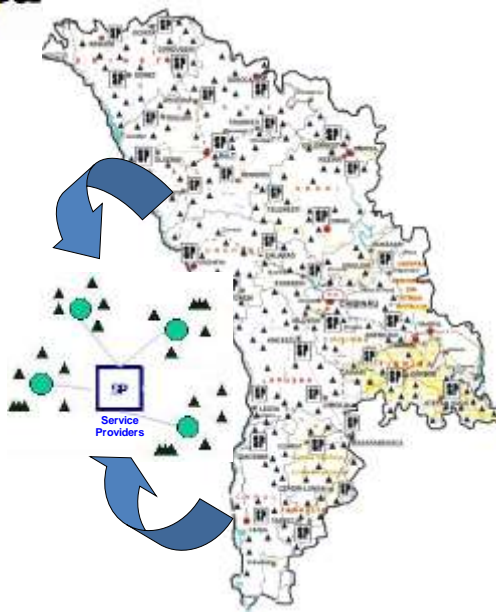

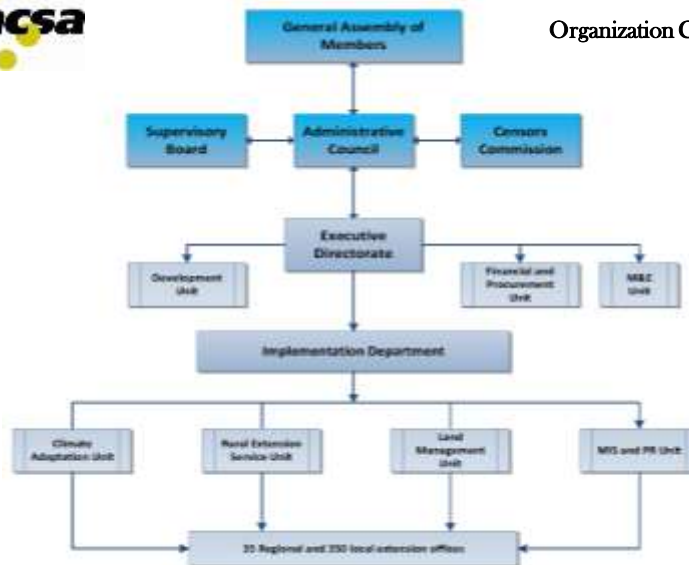
ACSA RES Network (36 NGO)

Projects implemented in 2014 - 2015:

11. Information campaign, consultancy and training in Voluntary Guidelines on Responsible Governance of Tenure of Land (VGGTs) principles: current situation and feasible solutions
 - ✓ ACSA and MAFI team participated at several meetings and seminars, including the seminar organized by FAO in Kiev
 - ✓ ACSA elaborated the practical guide based on the FAO experience, but also the situation in Moldova
 - ✓ A national information seminar was organized with circa 100 participants and a training seminar (ToT) for 35 trainers was conducted
 - ✓ 35 district-level information and training seminars were conducted and counted over 1100 participants
 - ✓ 350 community-level information sessions were carried out amounting over 7800 participants

The presence of the rural extension network formed of over 450 consultants enables the information campaign to be carried out in a continuous manner.
