FEEDING

- Poor pasture management
 - Processing and storage problems
 - Poor quality

 - Reducing feed waste and improving quality
 - Crop residues and agro-industry byproducts

BREEDING AND ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION

- Better breeds are needed
 - Insufficient understanding of cows' reproductive physiology
 - Lack of information on breeding

- AI with selection programs
 - Animal Identification Systems
 - Performance recording and estimation of bulls' breeding values

- Poor equipment and technologies
- Obsolete dairy and animal health practices
- Absence of effective advisory services
