• Participation

"Participation is a process through which stakeholders influence and share control over development initiatives and the decisions and resources which affect them." (World Bank, 1996)

IWG-PA (FAO initiative) – process of involvement of all stakeholders in designing development strategies and policies, as well as in all phases of development activities

Some keywords: **dialogue** among **actors**, **respect** opinions, values and norms, **communication** and active listening, **interests**, **negotiation**, partnerships, **decision-making**

All individuals, groups or organizations (any kind) that are affected by the outcome or those who can affect the outcome of an intervention / project


