Innovative Elements in Land Consolidation

- Improving decision-making process underlying land consolidation
- Creating trust through improving transparency and participation of the involved stakeholders
- Establish a Board of Participants representing the interests of all land consolidation participants
- Land Consolidation Commissions are monitored
- Regular meetings with landowners for feedback in the process



Change of Methodology and Regulations

- Clarification of the mandates & roles
- Improve methodology for land valuation
- Environmental impact assessment as integral part of the plan of common facilities
- Bringing best practices into law & regulations with public participation



Capacity Development

- Elaboration of procedures, manuals and PR materials
- Public Awareness Campaigns
- Training of Land Consolidation Commission, Sub-commissions, Board of Participants, Environmental Experts
- Establishment of Networks and Peer-to-peer learning (seminars, conferences, study tours)
