- Adjust to the event and audience (outfit, language, behavior, discussion...)
- Be on time (arrange good timing)
- Present yourself
- Present the content
- Present the team
- Study good the presentation (practice the presentation)
- Don't read from the slides unless necessary. Instead, make notes

- Speak slowly, loud and understandably
- Follow and control the audience
- Let audience participate in the context
- Write with big CAPITAL letter
- Don't stand in front of flip chart
- Don't turn back to audience
- Engage all participants
 - Allow time for questions at the end
 - Encourage questions/clarifications throughout the presentation
- Deal with the participant not interested or interrupting the work
- Make your own notes
