

Preparedness


- Knowledge, information, intelligence

- Awareness risk communication





of Risk-Analysis

Risk-Assessment & risk management are components

- 1. Hazard Identification (eg LSD)
- 2. Risk Assessment
- 3. Risk Management
- 4. Risk Communication







Practical Approach no "Zero Risk" "Acceptable" Risk Limited resources; legal, financial, human Risk-Based- surveillance, management... Achievable Objectives; Early detection...containment... Elimination / control



- Risk aversion






Risk aversion

- Response/ preference to risk uncertainty
- Decisions about livestock diseases control are risky
- PI = Probability X Impact
- "Catastrophic risks";
 - low probability of occurrence (rare events)
 - major adverse impact/ losses (severe events)
 - decision-makers try to avoid negative outcomes (risk aversion)
- Clear/ minimize the uncertainty
 - information
 - preparedness


- Simple, factual, clear

- Written- clear, simple, lean
- Fliers, handouts, billboards
- Media- electronic, social
- E-mail, sms, whatsapp, twit "push"
- Website "pull"- less effective!

Suspicion- before official confirmation (first 24 hours)	Farmers Vets processors stakeholders	Possibility of LSD incursion Temporary stand still of cattle movements Biosecurity measures Revise request for immediate reports Revise sampling instructions
Immediately after official confirmation (24 – 48 hours)	Farmers Vets processors Stakeholders OIE	Official notification Sites and period of cattle restrictions Cattle vaccination/ culling and compensation possibility Cleaning and disinfection activities Handling of dead animals and contaminated materials
Extended period (After 48 hours)	Farmers Vets processors stakeholders	Inform all the cattle owners, transporters and slaughterers Period and procedures of restrictions Culling and financial aid for cattle owners Cleaning and disinfection activities Biosecurity measures to mitigate the transmission risk

Summary ✓ Learn and plan - don't "copy-paste"

- ✓ Clear chain of command & decision making
- ✓ LSD (any TAD) effective control relies on;
 - ✓ Communication & collaboration
 - ✓ Transparency
