RI SSA

- 8 countries constitute the focus of the SSA RI. Support extended to all countries as requested (e.g. Iran UTF)
- Areas of work have been reduced from 8 to 3
- Regional component is important for experience, knowledge sharing and commonalities

SP3

- Country is central in the planning process
- Improved communication and strong collaboration between CO, RI and HQs have part in identifying clear roadmaps
- An Inter-regional meeting will take place to learn from “sister” initiatives (RLC & REU)

RI FSN

- 11 focus countries with 5 key focus areas
- Strong links with SO1, SO4 and SO5
- Synergies with 2 other RIs (Drought Reduction and Early Warning (WSE), Food Waste and Loss & Social Protection (SSA))

SP5

- Overview of activities undertaken in 2014-15 biennium based on country-specific requests
- Overview of required support over 2016-17 based on country work plans
- Importance of the use of limited RB resources to engage with partners and make the difference at country level
- Identification of resources to be done through the FSN RI at regional level and the MAWs at global level
- Overview of strategic leadership by policy processes and main delivery mechanism
